



Soke Cluster Sport Partnership

Context

The Soke Cluster of Primary Schools is uniquely represented by:

Barnack, Castor, Duke of Bedford, John Clare, Newborough, Northborough, Peakirk cum Glinton and Wittering, commonly known as the rural schools and Gunthorpe, Norwood, Welbourne, Werrington and William Law C of E (A), commonly known as the Werrington schools.

The Soke Cluster Sport Partnership is committed to networking and inter-school competition and continuous professional development (CPD). It is envisaged that the specific provision for all primary schools in the Soke Cluster will be met by Arthur Mellows Village College.

This is a Service Level Agreement (SLA) between all the Soke Primary Schools (see above) and Arthur Mellows Village College (AMVC). This document is an Agreement stating the responsibilities between both parties with regard to the provision of a primary sports.

The Service

Provide an agreed high quality service (see details below) to develop Physical Education (PE) and Sport across the Soke Cluster Sport Partnership.

Period of agreement:

2 years commencing 1 September 2017 concluding 31 August 2019.

Changes to SLA

Changes to this SLA will be subject to agreement of all parties, which could reflect programme, coverage and change of a specific focus.

In partnership with each Cluster Primary School AMVC will:

1. Be responsible for delivering the agreed sports programme (see specific expectations below).
2. Research additional sporting opportunities and signposting to further develop the PE and sports provision between AMVC and all Cluster Primary Schools and action this where it has been mutually agreed.
3. Work with each Cluster Primary school to develop school specific outcomes for the Strand 3 – Sports coordinator school specific x 2 support days.

In partnership AMVC each Cluster Primary School will:

1. Provide a dedicated member of staff to work with the AMVC Primary Sports Coordinator (otherwise known as a Primary Link Teacher - PLT).
2. Provide PLT/other teacher release time to support the development of the agreed programme.

Performance Monitoring of the Service and Quality Assurance

- Evaluation forms will be used to capture specific quality and impact measures after each event/activity.
- A termly review and update on progress to fulfill the agreed programme.
- Provide an annual review including data to support the completion of the Ofsted Sports Premium report.
- Termly PLT meeting to monitor the service, network and involve an element of training.

Charge for the service

- Each named primary school will make an annual contribution of £3,600 towards the cost of the Sports Cluster Partnership to AMVC.
- Payment will be required in two instalments due November (£2,000) and June (£1,600) each year in line with government funding. Invoices will be sent to each school at the start of each academic year.
- Part refunds will not be allowed if a school does not attend a particular event or utilise Primary Sports Coordinator time efficiently.

Core Expectations

The table below sets out the range and extent of core activities

3	Primary School Specific SSCO CPD, coaching or support Purpose: To raise the quality of teaching of PE 2 days Coordinator input per school per year which will be tailored to meet the individual needs of that school.	Minimum time in school to be ½ day due to distances especially for rural schools Secondary Timetable constraints mean not ALL days will be available but will be mutually agreed as far as possible
4	Cluster PLT Professional Development, Training and networking	3 sessions (pm) At least 1 of these sessions will be a full afternoon beginning at 1.30 to support the completion of Kitemark
5	To enhance and develop primary pupil sports leadership. To support festivals, competitions and primary school Sports Days with AMVC leaders, wherever possible	AMVC leaders at all AMVC competitions and where possible to support primary competitions eg sports days. AMVC bespoke primary leadership course is free. Specific Sportsleaders Award if chosen is at an additional cost of £10 per pupil. Yr5/6 leadership course time requires 1.5-2 full days depending on school size. Any extra time used over ½ a day will come from Strand 3-School Specific Time. Larger 2-3 form entry schools may need to select students to participate or use other primary teachers to run the course in addition to AMVC staff
6	To support the completion of the annual Sport Premium Ofsted Audit/questionnaire/kitemark To provide a termly update for the Soke Primary Headteachers feeding back progress towards completion of the agreed programme.	Review document to be sent termly to Headteachers and PLT's

In addition there will be Free loan of Sport Equipment (ie Top Sport etc) to enhance the quality of resources available to primary schools, though the amount available is limited.
